What does your organisation do and who does it support? (300 word limit)

We are a volunteer run group which supports people in the community through providing opportunities to take part in sport and physical activities, community social events and cultural exchange events to support integration. Our community has high levels of poverty and deprivation and many of the people we support are families who are struggling financially, including asylum seeker/refugee families and those from ethnic minority backgrounds. Our activities aim to promote community cohesion and integration and through these we are able to identify those who may need additional support. We provide support/signposting to other agencies for help such as access to foodbanks,

welfare benefits advice and local training/upskilling opportunities. Over the past year we were able to distribute iPad/tablet devices to families struggling with exclusion and isolation and our digital champion volunteers provided training for parents, carers and children on their use. Our work has had a huge impact on families and individuals within the community who are struggling due to the cost of living crisis and has hugely improved their mental wellbeing.

Please tell us about the work you would like us to fund and how this will make a difference in your community (300 word limit)

We would like funding towards our running costs to deliver these activities and events and support people with any issues they may be experiencing. Our sports sessions are well attended by children & young people, many of who might not otherwise access extracurricular activities. We would also like to run some day trips during the summer holidays for local families, as many aren't able to afford these, and arts/crafts classes for children. All of our activities/events are free to attend, to ensure cost is not a barrier, and we offer food/snacks as part of these. We expect our work to benefit approximately 100 families over the year ahead.

How does this work involve your community? (300 word limit)

All our committee members and volunteers are from the area and understand the issues local people experience. We work closely with the local community centre, who provide us with low cost space to deliver our activities. Our committee/volunteers come from all walks of life and many have themselves experienced hardship so know what it's like to struggle. We regularly engage with other community groups and encourage feedback from parents/carers.
